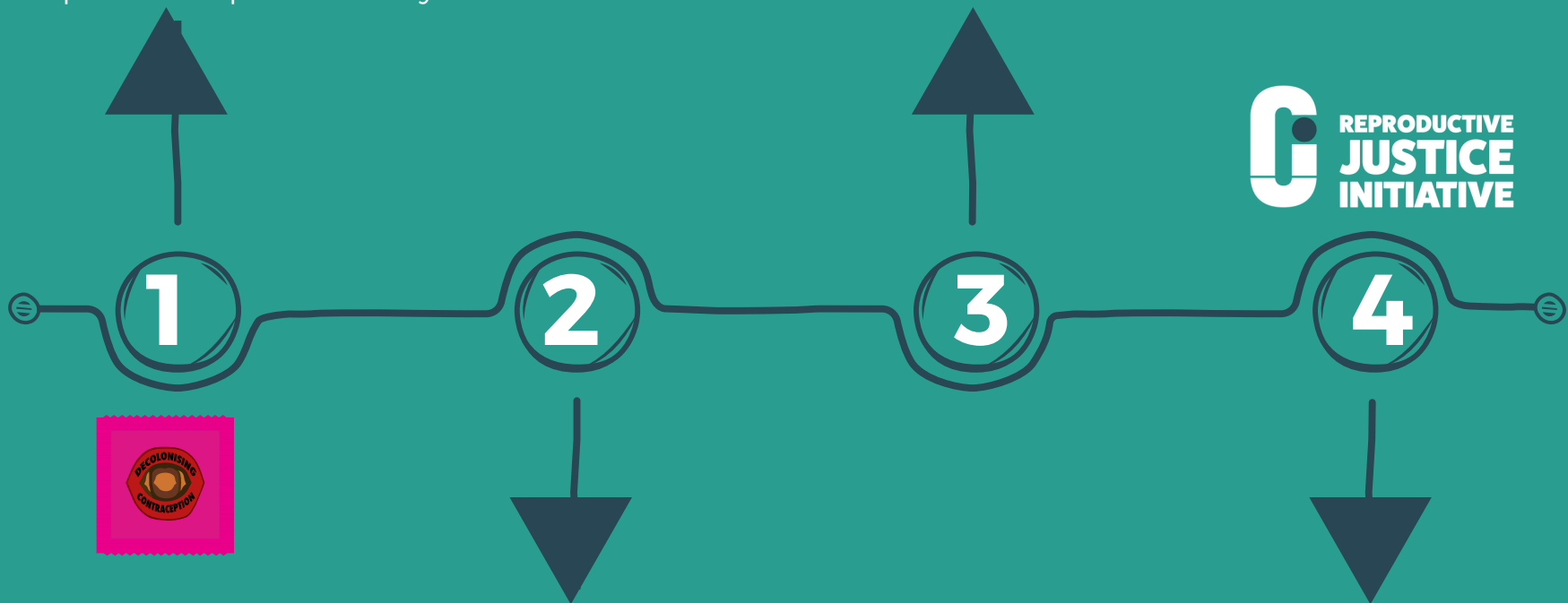
RESEARCH, POLICY AND ADVOCACY

OUR JOURNEY

Decolonising Contraception CIC was established as a community interest company in **2018**. For and by **Black** and **People of Colour** working in sexual and reproductive health (SRH), as a radical and urgent response to inequalities experienced by our communities.

We built **global coalitions** both within and outside the SRH field which led to us learning and expanding the scope of our practice. We won the **Grassroots initiative of the Year 2020** at the **Sexual Health Awards**.



We built an **interdisciplinary** collective, working in sexual and reproductive health, including **sex educators, doctors, campaigners, journalists** and **researchers**. Together we produced work across **public engagement, research, policy, advocacy** and **collective care**.

In **2022**, we transitioned into a charity, **Reproductive Justice Initiative**, to better reflect the reproductive justice work we are doing.
